I wanted to e-mail you all to say we will be starting up again next week with Lab 2.

Week A students will meet up next week (week 7) and week B students will meet up the following week (week 8).

As a reminder, **your prelabs will be due by 8 AM CST on the morning of your lab session**. This week, we are asking as part of your prelab that you and your teammates **brainstorm a method by which you can use your IOLab device to measure the coefficient of static friction between its red felt pads and a flat surface of your choosing**. Your team's PI will then be describing your method at the start of Lab 2. After that, all teams will go off and compare the results of two such measurements to see if they are consistent with one another.
