Use the same paper that you chose for last week's assignment. This homework consists of two parts:

1. Analyze the title of the paper, using the criteria presented in the January 19 class lecture. Is the paper's title concise and descriptive? Will it capture a busy reader's attention and interest? Write a one-paragraph evaluation of the title and either discuss what is good about the title or suggest how it might be improved.
2. Next, write an appropriate abstract for the paper, following the lessons from the February 2 lecture (remember MMRC!).

If you are having any trouble understanding the physics concepts presented in the paper, schedule an appointment with Professor Grosse Perdekamp. (Do not wait until Thursday at midnight to start the assignment.)

Be sure to clearly indicate on your submission which paper you are writing about.
