Logon

The computers on the 5th and 6th floors of ESB are accessed with your Active Directory (AD) account using the following information:

UserName: NetID
Password: AD Password
Domain: UIUC

If you have set up netfiles, use that password to log on. However, this account is inactive by default. If you cannot log on using the above method, you will need to follow the directions below to set up your Active Directory password:

1. Go to the website: <http://accounts.ad.uiuc.edu/>
2. Under the heading Reset Your Password, click on the link: login to set your AD password.
3. You will be asked to enter your NetID and bluestem password (If you have forgotten this password, call the Cites help desk 244-7000).
4. You will now need to create an AD Password and Confirm that password.
5. Note: You do not need to unlock your account, so do not click this option. You should now be able to log on using this password.

Saving Data

Network storage:

Space has been allocated for students to store files. Please store all data in this folder or in your netfiles space (see below) and do not use the local computer to store files. The location of the class data storage is:

<\\Phyaplportal\\Phycs401\\>

To access your network storage area:

1. Look for the shortcut on the desktop, it should be called phyics401 on phyaplportal.
2. Or, go to Start→Run, then type:

[\\Phyapportal\Phycs401\](\\Phyapportal\Phycs401\\)

And click OK. You can also browse to this area using Network Neighborhood.

3. Create a new folder and name it "YourNetID". This new folder is your network storage area – you should be able to create, store, revise, and delete files in this folder.

Netfiles:

For access to data off campus, consider setting up your netfiles storage area. Every UIUC student is allocated 100 mb of space located at:

<http://netfiles.uiuc.edu>

The first time you use netfiles, click on [http://netfiles/uiuc.edu/signup](http://netfiles.uiuc.edu/signup) and follow directions. Note: You will have to sign up in 257 Loomis or at home before using – unfortunately the signup page does not load properly in ESB. Once set up, this area can be used to store data through the web interface and can be accessed off campus.
