## Homework Assignment #1, Evaluating Scientific Presentations

Make sure your criticisms are thoughtful and constructive and provide useful feedback to the speaker.

<u>Part 2</u>: On the last page of the evaluation sheet, rank the three best speakers and justify your opinions (two or three sentences for each speaker).

Your rankings will be tabulated and used to determine the annual "People's Choice Award" winner for the symposium.
