Problem 4 (20 points)

Prove the following expressions for the γ -matrices:

$$\gamma_\mu \gamma^\mu = 4$$

$$\gamma_\mu \not{\epsilon} \gamma^\mu = -2 \not{\epsilon}$$

$$\gamma_\mu \not{\epsilon} \not{b} \gamma^\mu = 4a \cdot b$$

$$\gamma_\mu \not{\epsilon} \not{b} \not{c} \gamma^\mu = -2 \not{c} \not{b} \not{\epsilon}$$

$$\gamma_\mu \not{\epsilon} \not{b} \not{c} \not{d} \gamma^\mu = 2 \not{d} \not{\epsilon} \not{b} \not{c} + 2 \not{c} \not{b} \not{\epsilon} \not{d}$$

Problem 5 (25 points)

Prove the following trace theorems:

a) Trace of an odd number of γ'_μ s vanishes.

b) $\text{Tr}(\not{\epsilon} \not{b} \not{c} \not{d}) = 4[(a \cdot b)(c \cdot d) - (a \cdot c)(b \cdot d) + (a \cdot d)(b \cdot c)]$

c) $\text{Tr}(\gamma_5 \not{\epsilon} \not{b}) = 0$

d) $\text{Tr}(\not{\epsilon}_1 \cdot \cdot \cdot \not{\epsilon}_n) = a_1 \cdot a_2 \text{Tr}(\not{\epsilon}_3 \cdot \cdot \cdot \not{\epsilon}_n) - a_1 \cdot a_3 \text{Tr}(\not{\epsilon}_2 \not{\epsilon}_4 \cdot \cdot \cdot \not{\epsilon}_n) + \cdot \cdot \cdot$
 $+ a_1 \cdot a_n \text{Tr}(\not{\epsilon}_2 \cdot \cdot \cdot \not{\epsilon}_{n-1})$
